I entreat you to seriously consider the provision of one person flats / apartments for MPs - like good quality student accommodation for their London overnight stays.

If they choose to rent or buy other properties, this is their own choice and their own expense. If there is not enough such accommodation, an allowance against rent can be given, but only that which the basic provided accom. would cost.

I have heard that the Olympic village accommodation may not have purchasers. Could that be bought for this purpose?

Re-imbusement of all of mortgage interest payment is NOT acceptable for large London properties.
Also for purchases of all but very basic goods.

The London home is for business use. The constituency home is the main home and no help should be given for this, except allowable expenses for tax purposes - as allowed by the Revenue to self-employed people using part of their homes as office space.
