Accommodation for MPs in London

I see from press reports that you are considering a scheme whereby MPs would be offered London accommodation in properties leased by the State, thus eliminating the question of their having second home expenses.

I would commend to you the following suggestion.

The State purchase a redundant cruise liner, or even convert a redundant warship, and use this for accommodating MPs when they are working in London. It could easily be moored off the House of Commons water frontage, in much the same manner that HMS Belfast is moored not far away. Their individual security would not be a problem and they would be close to their place of work.
