- 5) AGREED FIXED FIGURE FOR SECRETARIAL ALLOWANCE (BASED ON NATIONAL FIGURES)
- 6) NO SUCH THING AS FOOD EXPENSES
- 7) MORE M.P.S CONTRIBUTION TO THEIR PENSION
- 8) REDUCTION IN M.P.s NUMBERS.
- 9) PAY INCOME TAX AS PUBLIC DOORS.
